She has an <u>Etenwolf Air Compressor Vortex S6.</u>

Here are the components of the air compressor.

- Range 160 psi
- Start/pause
- Mode car, bike camper, air mattress
- Unit psi, kPa, bar
- Pressure adjustment
- 31 inch high pressure hose
- High volume hose
- Battery 19,200 mAH
- On Back extra nozzles, C port, USB-A, 12 Volt
- On Side high volume ports for deflation and inflation
- Charge time for a full battery 2.5 hours

When set pressure is reached, it turns off automatically.'

It also turns off automatically after 5 minutes, if there is no usage.

Cost - \$100 with Amazon Prime.

Margaret has used her air compressor 9 times and it still has battery life.

 - 3. What's Going on at the Corvette Assembly Plant?

Corvette announced the ZR1 with 1,064 horsepower. No production start date announced, nor price. They have built 41 so far, some captured test fleet which will be sold. Available in all colors/interiors but only 1LZ or 3LZ. Sightings @ the Nurburgring of the next C8, the Zora. Probably 1,200+ hp. Just can't get enough horsepower.

2024 Production numbers are not available yet. Latest as of 9/9/24 were 30,304 Stingrays and 10,013 Z06 and 1,199 E-Rays produced.

Regular Stingray production for 2025 started September 9th. Production as of 10/2 2,037 Stingrays, Z06 697 and E-Rays 93. No word on ZR1/

Still having Carbon Fiber parts and wheel shortages. Constraints are hit and miss depending on the vendor shortages.

New exterior colors for 2025 have been announced. Arctic White, Black, Torch Red, Riptide Blue, Rapid Blue, Red Mist Metallic, Sea Wolf Gray and new Hysteria Purple. And Competition Yellow returns as does Sebring Orange. New interior color is Habanero. Following the re-sale of Z06s on BAT and Hemmings, the prices are falling. The lowest was \$128k for an LT2 coupe.

Regular Stingrays and Z51s resale prices

have also dropped and they are not selling as fast.
